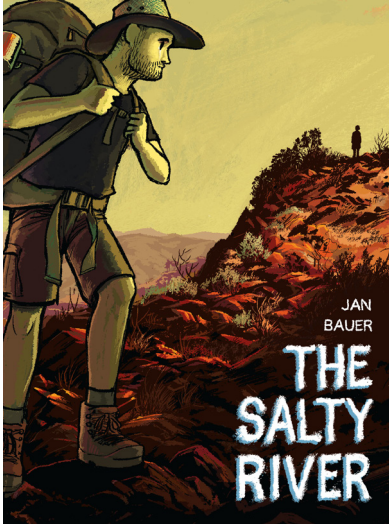

ABOUT THE AUTHOR

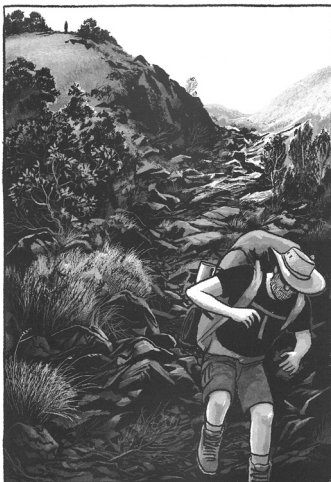
